IN ORDER TO USE THE LOGO, IT IS NECESSARY TO PAY ATTENTION TO THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

- <u>It must be clear</u> that the certification relates exclusively to the certified management system and that it is not a product certification
- The standard applicable to the Certified Management System <u>must be reported</u>
- You can check the validity of your certificate using the IAF Cert Search, the worldwide certification database, which only includes valid certificates issued by a certification body accredited by an IAF MLA signatory accreditation body (https://www.iafcertsearch.org/).
- Certificates issued under UKAS (https://services.accredia.it/ppsearch/accredia_companymask_remote. jsp?ID_LINK=1739&area=310) also have an additional link to the list of certified companies on their institutional website.

- On material relating to products/services/production sites that are not covered by the certification purpose
- On any attestations or certificates of qualification and/or competence issued by the client organisation

USE OF ACCREDITATION LOGOS BY CERTIFIED ORGANISATIONS

FOR CERTIFICATIONS ISSUED UNDER ACCREDITATION, IT IS PERMITTED THE USE OF THE LOGO OF THE ACCREDITATION BODY BUT ONLY IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE A CUBE TIC LOGO







IN ORDER TO USE THE LOGO, IT IS NECESSARY TO PAY ATTENTION TO THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENT

- The logo of the Accreditation Body must always appear alongside the ACT logo
- The Accreditation logo <u>must show the accreditation number of ACT</u> if present in the submitted file (e.g. UKAS 0273)
- Between the ACT logo and the Accreditation Body logo no other elements can be inserted
- The ACT and accreditation logos must be reproduced using the same height, if enlarged or reduced they must retain the same proportions and remain readable

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR UKAS LOGO

- The reference height of the logo for an A4 sheet is 30 mm dimensions may vary proportionally depending on the size of the printing surfaces
- The logo may not be less than 20 mm high (excluding the accreditation number which will be adjusted proportionally) exceptions to this measure are possible in exceptional cases, but the logo must be legible throughout
- The UKAS logo shall **NOT** be reproduced on vehicles and flags
- The UKAS logo shall **NOT BE APPLIED** to laboratory test, calibration, or inspection reports

- UKAS marks may only be used by A Cube Tic clients in connection with the issue of UKAS accredited certification and in conjunction with the A Cube Tic's mark. SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR UAF LOGO

- UAF marks may only be used by A Cube Tic clients in connection with the issue of UAF accredited certification and in conjunction with the A Cube Tic's mark. Holders of certificates issued by A Cube Tic may use the appropriate national accreditation mark on stationery and publicity material. For the purposes of these conditions the term 'publicity material' shall not include notices, labels, documents, or written announcements affixed to or otherwise appearing on goods or products unless the goods or products. This restriction shall also apply to primary (Example blister packs) packaging and promotional products. The terms 'publicity material' and 'advertisements' shall not include notices, labels, documents or written announcements affixed to or otherwise appearing on the vehicles or flags.
- The UAF logo may **NOT BE APPLIED** to laboratory test, calibration, or inspection reports
- SIZE: When the A Cube Tic /UAF mark is printed on an unfolded portion of stationery sized no greater than A4, UAF symbol shall normally have a minimum height of 10 mm and minimum width of 15mm. Any enlargement if necessary, provided that the original proportion between the height and width of the symbol will not be affected and the symbol remains legible. magnifying glasses). The Symbol shall not be displayed in a more prominent way than the logo of the A Cube TIC Limited.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCREDIA

ssue Marks A.2 - Date 01.09.202

- The ACCREDIA mark MUST be positioned to the right of, and **NOT** larger than, the body mark. The dimensions may vary proportionally to the size of the printed area. The minimum size must not be less than 20 mm.
- The Accredia mark **SHALL NOT** include the accreditation number of the body.
- The certified company must **NEVER** use the ACCREDIA Logo separately from the ACT Logo
- The certified company must **NEVER** use the ACCREDIA Logo in a way that implies ACCREDIA has certified or approved the company's management system, or in any other **misleading manner**
- The certified company may use a statement without applying the logo, such as "Organization with certified management system (e.g., quality, environment)," the name of the accredited body, and the applicable standard

- The certified company may not use the ACCREDIA mark on its staff's business cards.
- The use of the ACCREDIA Logo, in conjunction with the ACT Logo, is allowed on letterhead and general documents (excluding any technical documentation related to the manufactured products or on assets and instrumental means used for the implementation of processes within the scope of the certified management system (such as commercial vehicles, buildings, lab coats, work overalls, and similar items), except for objects that are subject to specific certification, especially if mandatory or regulated (machinery, equipment, personal protective devices, etc.).
- For use on assets and instrumental means, the combination of the two Logos must be accompanied by the addition of a statement such as "Organization with certified management system (e.g., quality, environment)," the name of the CAB (Certification Accreditation Body), and the applicable standard.
